Drive to Civitavecchia & Embark Cruise

Tuesday · May 9th

Naples, Italy (for Pompeii and Amalfi Coast)

Dubrovnik, Croatia

From 8:00 AM - 7:00 PM

Thick 16th-century stone walls encase the entire Old Town of Dubrovnik. But there are no boundaries on the endless adventures you'll discover among its orange-roofed ramparts. With a made-for-TV appeal— Game of Thrones was actually filmed here— the city commands your attention with the perfectly preserved Rector's Palace, elaborate Onofrio's Fountain, and baroque St. Blaise's Church, named after the city's patron saint. You can browse museum collections showcasing Croatian artwork, period furniture and shipbuilding traditions. Stand in awe of the Franciscan Monastery library's 30,000 volumes. Or to get your heart pumping, go cliff diving into the sea and kayak crystal blue waters, with the 'Pearl of the Adriatic' shimmering in the distance.

Friday · May 12th

Split, Croatia

From 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM

Lying on the Adriatic Sea's eastern shore, Split is known for its terracotta roofs, whitewash buildings, palm tree-lined promenade and azure waters. Split has a long history, as it's home to Diocletian's Palace and the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, which were built for the Roman emperor in the 4th century. Always buzzing with tourists, Split balances its historic setting with a plethora of modern restaurants, bars and shops. Thanks to its Mediterranean climate, Split receives over 2,600 hours of sunshine every year.

Saturday · May 13th

Koper, Slovenia

From 9:00 AM - 7:00 PM

Tiny Slovenia may only have about 29 miles of coastline but the Slovenian Riviera — and particularly its jewel, the historic city of Koper — packs a big punch. Whether you explore 700 years of architecture, delve into the Slovenian wine scene or simply sun yourself on the pristine Adriatic, Koper is sure to be one of the most memorable stops on your next cruise. That's even before you consider the delicious fresh-caught seafood rizota (Slovenian risotto) and shopping for Slovenian handicrafts like handmade Idrija lace.

Sunday · May 14th

Ravenna, Italy - Disembark, Private Motorcoach to Milan, Sightseeing Tour, Lunch

Arrives at 6:00 AM

After disembarking in Ravenna, journey to Milan (3.5 hours). On arrival, enjoy a group lunch and sightseeing tour. Milan, a city of prosperity hailed as Italy's major center for business, fashion, design, media and publishing. Stand in the formidable presence of Milan's Gothic cathedral, the Duomo. See Michelangelo's last sculpture, the Rondanini Pietà. Explore the antique shops, clubs and "case di ringhiera" houses along the canals Naviglio Grande and Naviglio Pavese. Milan truly offers something for everyone, from history and architecture enthusiasts to aficionados of art and high fashion.

Monday · May 15th

Tour Concludes & Flight Home

Today your tour concludes. After breakfast, fly from Milan to home (arriving home the same day as departure).

COVID-19 Information

Outlined below are the current requirements for COVID vaccinations and testing (subject to change). As time grows closer to sailing, we will advise you of any changes.

- It is recommended that guests are fully vaccinated against COVID-19, if they are eligible.
- While vaccination documents will not be required to board sailings, we will ask that you disclose your vaccination status to us prior to boarding (via the app, on our website, or at the terminal). We recommend you bring your vaccination documents with you, in case local authorities or businesses in some destinations require it for entrance.
- Some of the destinations we visit require guests to be “up to date” with their vaccination status to go ashore. Those who are not “up to date” may require additional testing onboard prior to going ashore in certain ports.

Terms and Conditions

Deposit and Final Payment

A deposit of \$1000 per person + travel protection premium is due upon booking and to secure your reservation. Final payment is due on or before February 1, 2023.

Travel Protection

Travel Protection is optional and available for individuals. Two types of travel protection are available: Worldwide Travel Protector (WTP) and Worldwide Travel Protector with Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR). Cancellation Penalties with Travel Insured

All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellations made before February 1, 2023 are subjected to a cancellation administrative fee of \$100 per person and/or protection plan premium.

Cancellation Penalties without or Not Covered by Travel Insured

All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellations made before February 1, 2023 are subject to a cancellation handling fee of \$100 per person. Cancellations made after February 1, 2023 are non-refundable.

Travel/Health Policy

It is required that persons needing assistance be accompanied by a companion who is capable and totally responsible for providing that assistance.
